Bryony felt a valued team member of EST and with their support and encouragement she was able to build on her confidence and search for additional part time employment. Bryony's specific learning difficulties and dyslexia could of held her back in a working environment, however her determination to not let it hinder her has been inspirational to watch.

In September 2016 Bryony secured an additional part time job as a print assistant and thoroughly enjoys it, she quotes:
